

Chirocentrus

Cuvier 1816

chiro, Latinized from cheir or cheirós (Gr. χείρ, genitive χειρός), hand, homologous to the pectoral fin; centrum (L.), prickle or sharp point, referring to long, pointed osseous appendage at pectoral-fin base of C. dorab

Chirocentrus dorab (Fabricius 1775) Arabic vernacular for this fish [authorship often given as (Forsskål 1775)]

Chirocentrus nudus Swainson 1839 Latin for bare or naked, referring to what Swainson erroneously believed was a lack of scales (scales are small and easily lost)
