Euclichthys

McCulloch 1926

Eucla, referring to Great Australian Bight southwest of Eucla, Southern Australia, type locality of *E. polynemus*; *ichthys* (ἰχθύς), fish

***Euclichthys microdorsalis* Last & Pogonoski 2020** *micro-*, from *mikrós* (μικρός), small; *dorsalis* (L.), of the back, referring to relatively small first dorsal fin compared with that of its congeners

***Euclichthys polynemus* McCulloch 1926** *polý* (πολύ), many; *nemus*, unnecessary masculinization of *nēma* (νῆμα), thread or yarn, presumably referring to pelvic fins under head, each with four long, thread-like rays, the longest reaching the anus

***Euclichthys robersti* Last & Pogonoski 2020** in honor of Clive Roberts (b. 1952), Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa, for his “considerable” contribution to ichthyology, and who, with Chris Paulin, were the first to formally report on this fish in 1997
