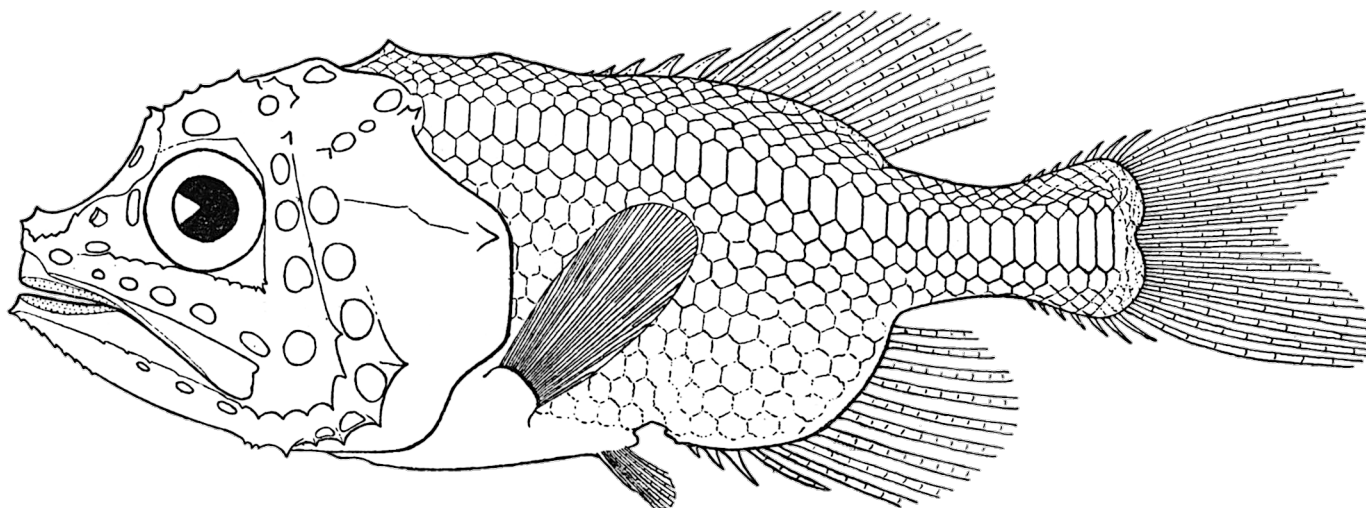

Family GIBBERICHTHYIDAE

Gibberichthys

Parr 1933

gibber (L.), humped, crooked or protuberant, allusion not explained, perhaps referring to "spiniferous crests" on head of *G. pumilus*;
ichthys (ἰχθύς), fish

Gibberichthys latifrons (Thorp 1969) *latus* (L.), wide or broad; *frons* (L.), forehead, referring to wider "fleshy interorbital distance" compared with *Kasidoron edom*, now known to be a prejuvenile stage (and junior synonym) of *G. pumilus*

Gibberichthys pumilus Parr 1933 Latin for dwarfish of diminutive, described at 31.5 mm SL
