krypto, from *crypta* (L.), vault, tunnel or cavern, referring to its “cryptic” habitat, a well fed by subterranean springs; *glánis* (Gr. γλάνις), ancient name for a silurid catfish (probably *Silurus aristotelis*), now used as a general term for catfish
