## Megalops

**Lacepède 1803** *mégas* (Gr. μέγας), big; *ốps* (Gr. ὦψ), eye, referring to large eye of *M. filamentosus* (=*cyprinoides*)

*Megalops atlanticus* Valenciennes 1847 -*icus* (L.), belonging to: referring to its distribution in the tropical Atlantic

**Megalops cyprinoides** (Broussonet 1782) -oides, Neo-Latin from eldos (Gr. είδος), form or shape: cyprinus, from kypriños (Gr. κυπρῖνος), carp, allusion not explained; since Broussonet placed it in the herring genus *Clupea*, perhaps he was referring to what could be perceived as its more carp-like rather than herring-like form or appearance
