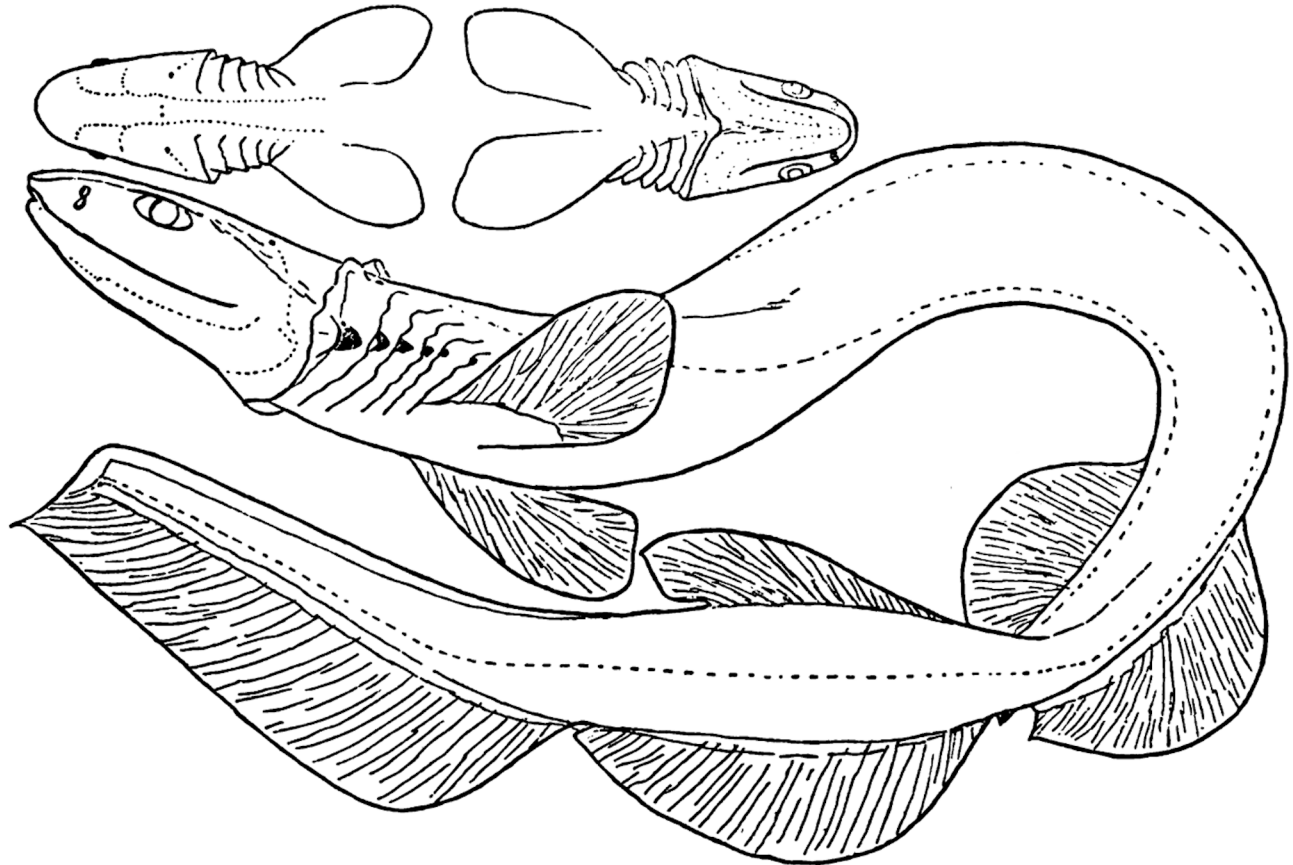

Chlamydoselachus

Garman 1884

chlamydos, from *chlamýs* (Gr.χλαμύς), cloak or mantle, referring to first pair of gill slits that fit like a cloak or frill around throat; *sélachos* (Gr. σέλαχος), a cartilaginous fish (i.e., shark or ray)

***Chlamydoselachus africana* Ebert & Compagno 2009** named for the Marine and Coastal Management research vessel *Africana* (Cape Town,

South Africa), from which a paratype was collected, for the “excellent” research surveys it has conducted over the past several decades

***Chlamydoselachus anguineus* Garman 1884** Latin for snake-like, referring to its snake- or eel-like shape
