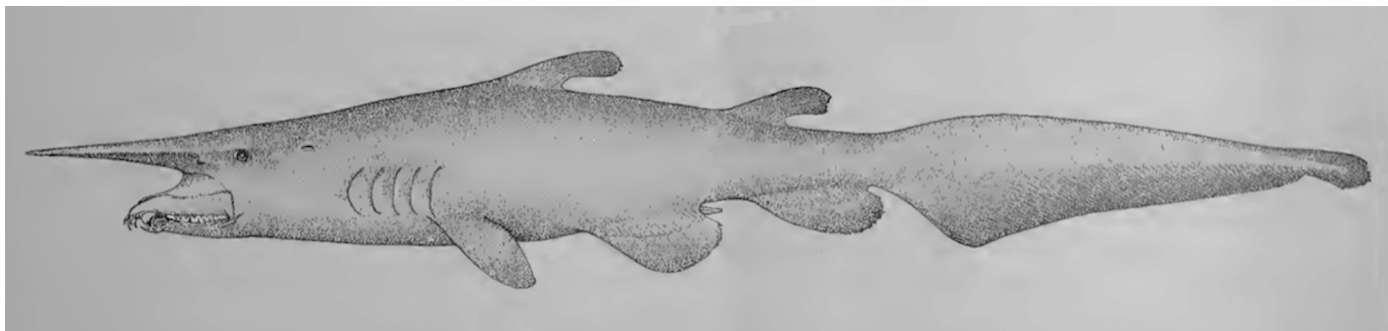

Mitsukurina

Jordan 1898

-ina (L.), belonging to: University of Tokyo zoologist Kakichi Mitsukuri (1858–1909), who placed holotype (provided by Alan Owston, see below) of this “very remarkable shark” in Jordan’s “hands to be identified, figured, and described”

***Mitsukurina owstoni* Jordan 1898** in honor of Alan Owston (1853–1915), English businessman, yachtsman, collector of Asian wildlife, and resident of Yokohama, Japan, who secured holotype from a fisherman (named for Owston at the request of Kakichi Mitsukuri, see above)
