Order STYLEPHORIFORMES


Family STYLEPHORIDAE Tube-eye

Stylephorus Shaw 1791

stylus, a style or projecting part; *phorus*, bearer, referring to the "very singular figure and situation of the eyes," which are large, telescopic and directed forwards or upwards

Stylephorus chordatus Shaw 1791

with a chord or string, referring to the "extraordinary thread-like process of the tail," i.e., an exceedingly long, cord-like appendage
